FIND YOUR IDEAL ACTIVITY LEVEL

Each Travel Program destination has a unique itinerary and the intensity of that itinerary is subject to your interpretation.

Tour Activity Levels can help you decide if a tour's pace is right for you. As you peruse this guide, you'll notice that each tour is given a 1-4 Activity Level ranking. Definitions for the four activity levels are listed below. If you have questions regarding a specific tour, please inquire at the time of reservation.

Level 1: You're a leisurely traveler. You like to discover the energy of a new place, but typically take it easy. You can handle at least one flight of stairs, board a coach, and walk for 15-30 minutes at a time with little difficulty.

Level 2: You like a balanced approach to travel. You feel confident walking at least 30-45 minutes at a time over a variety of terrains, but also need time to unwind and relax.

Level 3: You're an on-the-go traveler. Walking and standing for 1-2 hours at a time isn't a big deal. You can navigate hills and uneven ground, climb into various modes of transportation, and handle changes in elevation. You enjoy longer days balanced with free time.

Level 4: You're ready to seize the day, whatever it may bring. You lead an active life at home and a few thousand steps a day isn't out of the norm. You can handle 90+ minute walking tours, dusty or uneven terrain, and varying altitudes and temperatures. You don't mind early mornings, late-night activities, or full days. Unfortunately, this level is not appropriate for individuals who use wheelchairs or walkers.

Spotlights: With a Spotlights tour, you'll stay in one city and one hotel, so you can unpack and really settle into your surroundings. Alongside planned excursions to must-see destinations and hidden gems, these tours also include built downtime into the itinerary so you can explore your own way.

Classic: Classic tours are designed to let you experience multiple cities, countries, and destinations. Collette covers the details as you travel from one location to the next, so you can make the most of every moment. Edge of the World



n Patagonia, you'll encounter landscapes unlike any other towering glaciers, snowcapped mountains, and fjords that stretch endlessly into the horizon.

Your journey begins in Buenos Aires, where the vibrant rhythms

of a tango show immerse you in Argentine culture. Then, venture into the heart of Patagonia, where you'll visit a traditional estancia. Here, you'll meet a local gaucho and gaininsight into ranch life, from sheep herding demonstrations to a leisurely lamb roast.

Set sail on a 4-night cruise through the fjords, navigating past Glacier Alley, Pia Glacier, and Cape Horn. Explore Torres del Paine National Park, marvel at the Perito Moreno Glacier, and discover remote spots like Ainsworth Bay and Tucker Islets, where you may spot colonies of Magellanic penguins up close.

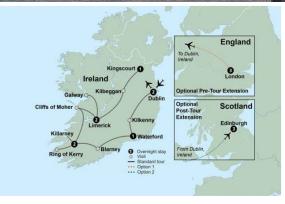
